







The 2022 physics prize – research on quantum mechanics

The physics prize 2022 is awarded for experiments that make it possible to investigate and control particles that are entangled through quantum mechanics.



The 2022 medicine prize is about genetic methods that can be used to map out human evolution and migration.







The 2022 laureates have clarified the important role banks play in financial crises. With the help of their work, recent economic crises have not developed into long-term economic depressions.


